

## T2.3 GO+LEARN EU Networking

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### 1. Summary of the meeting on October 29<sup>th</sup>.

The GO+LEARN EU Networking Workshop (T2.3) took place as an online meeting on October 29<sup>th</sup>, from 3 p.m. until 5.30 p.m, involving 6 participants.

After a presentation of the project VENHANS, its activities and related objectives, held by Giulia Meschino (EVTA), Andrea Giacomelli (ENAIP NET) presented the focus of the session and conducted the workshop.

The contents of the presentation were aimed at giving an overview about the *Go+learn initiative* and were illustrating the following aspects:

- Rational and Aims;
- The Go+Learn idea;
- Go+Learn Network;
- Go+Learn services;
- Go+Learn Website ([www.goandlearn.eu](http://www.goandlearn.eu)).

Originally the workshop was designed to be conducted in person, including also a practical session of group work to familiarize with the models of the documents, this activity was not held within the online meeting.

Having collected the feedbacks of the participants after the workshop, the following needs were expressed:

- more clarity with regards to the expectations and with regards to the next steps;
- additional examples and best practices would be helpful to better understand the initiative;
- clear identification of the benefits for the direct beneficiaries.

Receiving these inputs, a document defining the process of activation of both the EU Go+learn node, as well as the local one was prepared, clearly describing the tasks and defining the roles.

The document will be shared with the Umbrella Organisation and the participants of the workshop and a new meeting will be organised to discuss its implementation. In addition to this, the benefits of the application of the method Go+learn will be illustrated and discussed.
