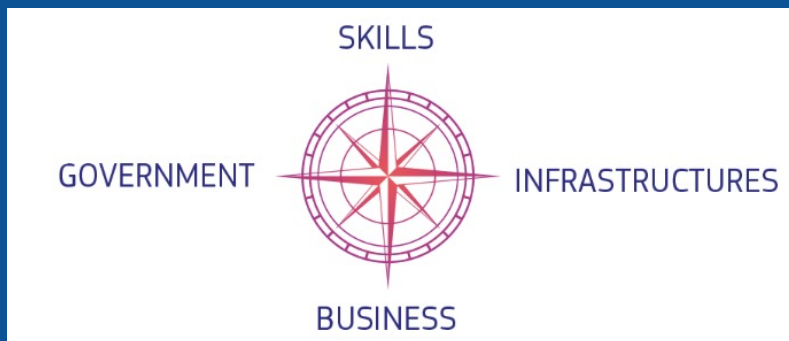

- **FINAL RESULT:** One “Recommendations for policy-makers” publication produced by each of the thematic groups
- **STYLE:** Concise and straight-to-the-point document
- **STRUCTURE:**
 1. Introduction and contextualisation of the topic by EVTA & ENAIP NET
 2. Identification of max. 5 recommendations per thematic group based on the contributions shared by the experts
 3. The recommendations will be the result of a shared analysis of the challenges and opportunities – examined for the involved target groups – related to the focus of the thematic group
